Services/Exams Provided (Air Force members must be on-time and in uniform)

1. **Armed Forces Classification Test (AFCT):** The AFCT evaluates airmen in the same four aptitude areas as the ASVAB; **taken post-enlistment.**
2. **Air Force Promotion Tests:** (Includes administration of SKTs, PFEs, and USAFSEs). These tests measure airmen's specialty and general military knowledge and produce test scores used in conjunction with other criteria for promotion.
3. **Air Force Officer Qualifying Test (AFOQT) / Enlisted Pilot Qualifying Test (EPQT):** The AFOQT is used to help select candidates for officer commissioning programs and to classify commissioned officers into utilization specialties. The EPQT is used to select enlisted candidates for Remotely Piloted Aircraft (RPA) training programs.
4. **Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB):** The ASVAB evaluates specific aptitude areas and provides a percentile score related to requirements for selecting and classifying individuals for the Armed Services; **taken pre-enlistment.**
5. **Electronic Data Processing Test (EDPT):** The EDPT evaluates the basic ability to complete formal courses for programming electronic data processing equipment. It is used to screen and select airmen for career fields requiring this ability.
6. **Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI):** An OPI is a test of a candidate's language listening comprehension and speaking ability, conducted under controlled conditions via telephone by two certified OPI raters.
7. **Test of Basic Aviation Skills (TBAS):** The TBAS measures cognitive, multi-tasking, and psychomotor attributes predictive of success in Air Force pilot (including RPA) training programs.
8. **Foreign Language Proficiency Bonus (FLPB):** is a monetary incentive paid to eligible and qualified military and civilian personnel possessing foreign language proficiency and is managed by the Military Testing Office
