## **Complete the SS-5 and submit the following documentation:**

(You must submit all of the applicable documents with your application)

- SS-5 Application (*may be typed or hand-written*)
  - o Link: <https://www.ssa.gov/forms/ss-5.pdf>
  - o **DO NOT** sign or date the application form until a Passport Agent is present and has reviewed it
- Notarized Copy of Current Valid Passport (tourist and official)
- Notarized Copy of Photo ID (front and back of military ID)
- Notarized Copy of Birth Certificate
- Notarized Copy of Marriage Certificate and/or Divorce Decree (or Name Change Doc if changing names)
- (1) One Royal Mail Letter envelope with prepaid postage up to 500g from the British post office.

## **For Children Age 17 and Under:**

- SS-5 Application (*may be typed or hand written*)
  - o Link: <https://www.ssa.gov/forms/ss-5.pdf>
  - o **DO NOT** sign or date the application form until a Passport Agent is present and has reviewed it
- Notarized Copy of Child's Current Valid Passport (tourist and no fee)
- Notarized Copy of Child's Consular Report of Birth Certificate
- Notarized Copy of Signing Parent's Current Valid Passport
- Notarized Copy of Signing Parent's Photo ID (front and back of military ID)
- (1) One Royal Mail Letter envelope with prepaid postage up to 500g from the British post office.

**THIS CHECKLIST IS BASED ON U.S. SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION AND U.S. EMBASSY REQUIREMENTS.**

**Please Note:** It's recommended to use a physical U.S. address on the SS-5. No original documents are required for this process unless the US Embassy/Federal Benefit Unit will require them.
